Painting or printing onto fabric using fabric paints, tseudiko inks or acrylic paints

Monoprinting using a Gelli plate. You can buy this or make your own using gelatin.

Printing using the item, leaves and flowers

Stamping onto fabric using household items or make your own designs using 'fun foam' sheets

Sundyeing or Ice dyeing fabric

Lino cut. Speedball Speedy Cut and lino cutting tools.

Printing onto fabric, Jacquard Fabric Sheets from Amazon

Using lettering cut using freezer paper or electronic cutter

For printing a brayer is a useful tool
