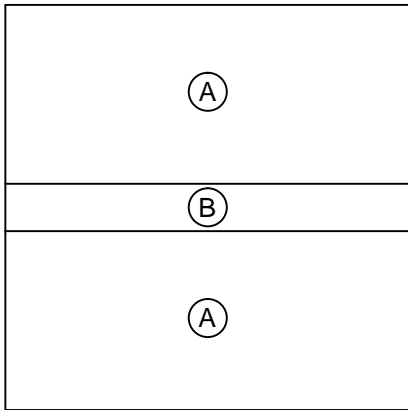


SFQG Fire Survivor Quilt Pattern

The requested size for the Fire Survivor lap quilts is 48"x60". Both of these block patterns make a 9" unfinished block. You will need to create or cut 42 blocks and arrange them into a 6x7 grid. You can use as many colors and amounts of either block as you want or add 9" squares of fabric, it's up to you. Yardage will vary based on your design and the layouts are just suggestions. Have fun with the blocks and arrange them anyway that makes you happy!

BLOCK 1



Sizes:

BLOCK 1

- A. (2) 4¼"x9" rectangles
- B. (1) 1½"x9" rectangle

BLOCK 2

- A. (2) 4¼"x9" rectangles
- (2) 1½"x4¼" rectangles
- B. (1) 1½"x1½" square

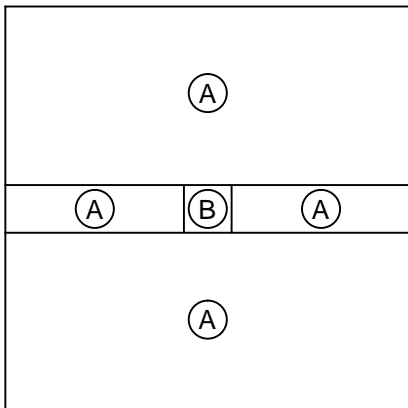
Assembly:

Block 1:

Strip piecing method

- Cut strips of fabric in the widths stated above 4¼" for A and 1½" for B.
- Sew these three strips together in the order shown to the left.
- Cut into 9" blocks

BLOCK 2



Block 2:

Single block method

- Cut a 4¼"x21" strip of fabric A.
- Cut off (2) 9" pieces and (2) 1½" pieces
- Cut (1) 1½"x1½" square from fabric B.
- Sew the (2) 1½"x4¼" rectangles of fabric A to the 1½"x1½" square of fabric B as shown to the left.
- Sew this new block to the (2) 4¼"x9" rectangles as shown to the left.
- This will be an unfinished 9" block.
