Monthly prompts will task you with adding to your quilt top featuring a specified pattern or motif.

You choose to interpret each round however you want - following a traditional style (medallion/row-by-row) or making a modern- or art quilt.

CHALLENGE: STRIP PIECING

Strip piecing, as the name suggests, is an efficient method of piecing that allows you to create checkerboards, nine patches, piano keys and even diamonds.

By piecing together a series of fabric strips you avoid having to cut many small pieces.



HERE'S WHERE I LEFT OFF AFTER ROUND 1 - POINTS




It's a big area, so I chose to go smaller with my next round

START WITH A BRIEF SKETCH

Row 2

Row 1



CHOOSE THE FABRICS



MAKE THE FIRST ROW OF 1 1/2" STRIPS



SLICE THEM INTO 1 1/2" ROWS




JOIN THEM TOGETHER TO MAKE 4 BORDERS



CUT 1 1/2" AND 2 1/2" STRIPS FOR THE NEXT ROW, JOIN THEM TOGETHER.

CUT 1 1/2" SLICES



JOIN THEM TOGETHER TO MAKE 4 BORDERS; ATTACH TO ROW 1



SOMEHOW MY CALCULATIONS WERE OFF BUT I FUDGED IT QUITE SUCCESSFULLY!



Remember – YOU CAN USE:

- Any colors
- Any fabrics
- Any techniques
- Any scale

ONE RULE: Whatever you make in one month must connect to the work from the month before. Strip piecing must connect to last month's points!
