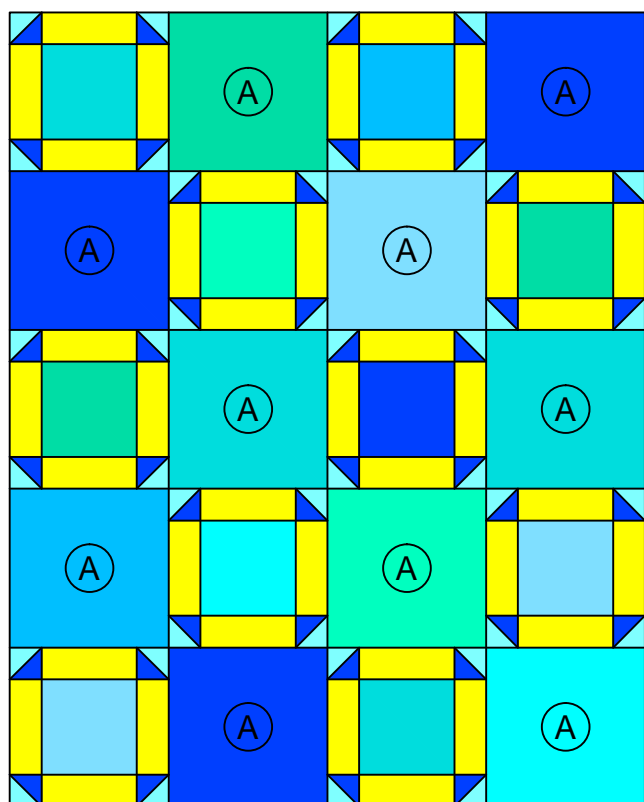


SFQG Community Outreach Pattern



Window Frames

Quilt Size: 40"x50"

Fabric Required:

- Fabrics A & B: 1 yard each of 2 novelty prints or scraps sufficient to cut (10) 10½" squares & (10) 6½" squares
- Fabric C: ½ yard medium fabric for sashing
- Fabric D & E: ¼ yard each of 2 coordinating fabrics (1 light & 1 dark) for (40) half-square triangle units (HST)
- Backing: 1½" yards
- Binding: ⅓" yard
- Batting: 1½" yards

Cut Fabric:

From each novelty fabric cut:

(5) 10½" squares & (5) 6½" squares

From fabric C, cut:

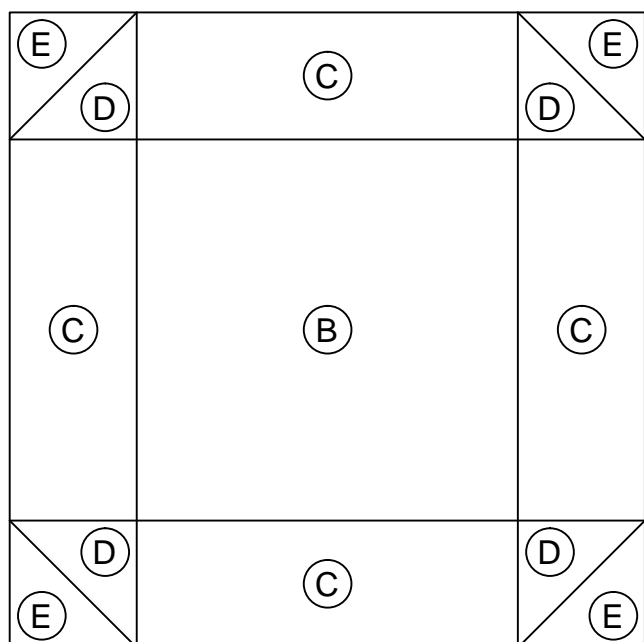
(40) 2½" X 6½" rectangles

From each of fabrics D & E cut:

(20) 3½" squares

From binding fabric cut:

(5) 2½" binding strips to make 190" of binding



Making half-square triangle (HST) units:

- Pair squares of fabric D & E right sides together.
- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
- Stitch ¼" on each side of the drawn line.
- Cut on the centerline.
- Press seam allowance to the dark fabric.
- Trim the HST units to 2½".

Assembly:

- Sew a sashing strip to two opposite sides of each 6½" square.
- Sew HST units to each end of the 2½" X 6½" sashing strips, as shown in the diagram.
- Sew the sashing/ HST units to the 6½" squares.
- Arrange blocks in a pleasing manner alternating large squares with blocks.
- Sew each 10½" square to a 10½" block.
- Sew two pairs of blocks together to form a row.
- Sew the rows together to make 5 rows.
- Sew the rows together.
- Press the finished top.

Quilting:

- Machine quilt a maximum of 4" apart.
