

# SFQG Community Outreach Pattern





### 4 Jellies & A Fat Quarter

Quilt Size: 40" X 48"


#### Fabric Required:


- A: (2) Fat Quarters for  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- B & C: (16)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips cut into  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- D & E: (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips cut into  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- Backing & Batting: 48" X 54"
- Binding: 191"

#### Assembly:

- Cut A into (30) 4½" squares'
- Sew (8) B to (8) C, press and cut into  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- Sew (4) D to (4) E, press and cut into  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- · Assemble block as shown to left.
- Square up to 8½"
- Layout is only a suggestion, have fun with placement.
- Sew the blocks together 5 to a row.
- Sew the rows together to make 6 rows.
- Press the finished top.
- Machine quilt a maximum of 4" apart.

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
