
## SFQG Community Outreach Pattern



### Rail Fence

Quilt Size: 40" X 50"

#### Fabric Required:

- A: (10) 4"x42" strips of a medium or dark fabric
- B: (5) 4"x42" strips of a light fabric
- Backing & Batting: 46" X 56"
- Binding: 195"


### Assembly:


- Sew (1) strip of A to B
- Sew (1) strip of A to the other side of B
- $\bullet$  Press. This should be  $10 \frac{1}{2}$  " wide and at least 42" long
- Cut (4) 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" blocks from strip
- Repeat the first 4 steps (4) more times
- Sew the blocks together 4 to a row, rotating direction
- Sew the rows together to make 5 rows.
- Press the finished top.

### Quilting:

• Machine quilt a maximum of 4" apart.

## Rail Fence

Quilt Size: 40" X 50"

### Fabric Required:

- A: (10) 4"x42" strips of a medium or dark fabric
- B: (5) 4"x42" strips of a light fabric
- Backing & Batting: 46" X 56"
- Binding: 195"

### Assembly:

- Sew (1) strip of A to B
- Sew (1) strip of A to the other side of B
- $\bullet$  Press. This should be  $10 \frac{1}{2}"$  wide and at least 42" long
- Cut (4) 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" blocks from strip
- Repeat the first 4 steps (4) more times
- Sew the blocks together 4 to a row, rotating direction
- Sew the rows together to make 5 rows.
- Press the finished top.

### Quilting:

• Machine quilt a maximum of 4" apart.
