## SFQG Community Outreach Kit



## Window Frames

Included in your kit are 20 pre-cut squares and enough fabrics for you to cut and assemble the 10 blocks to be sewn. This will make a 40"X50" lap quilt when finished.

## Materials:

A. (10) 10-1/2" print squares
B. (10) 6-1/2" print squares
C. $1 / 2$ yd uncut fabric for
(40) 2-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2$ " rectangles
D. $1 / 4$ yd uncut light fabric for (20) 2-1/2" half triangle squares
E. 1/4 yd uncut dark fabric for (20) 2-1/2" half triangle squares

## Assembly:

- For cutting rectangle $C$ there is enough fabric in the $1 / 2$ yd that when folded with selvedges matching you can get (7) 2-1/2" strips. Cut each 2-1/2" strip into (3) 6-1/2" rectangles. You should have a couple extra.
- For making the 2-1/2" half triangle squares there is enough fabric included to cut (40) 3 " squares, (20) from fabric $D$ and (20) from fabric E. You are welcome to use what ever method you prefer for making the half square triangles.
- Using the (10) 6-1/2" print squares B start assembling your blocks using the diagram to the left.
- When finished assembling, iron and square up each block to 10-1/2".
- Taking your (10) 10-1/2" print squares and your (10) 10-1/2" blocks arrange them in an alternating pattern as show in the color diagram above, trying not to place fabrics that are the same next to each other.
- Sew together and give a nice iron.
