Interlocking 9 Patch Due September 16th or October 21st

This block is a simple 1/2 square triangle nine patch that makes an interesting interlocking pattern when repeated.

Materials:

You will need:

- Two 4.5" solid lavender or orchid squares
- Two 4.5" printed squares that look nice with your lavender squares
- Four 4.5" white squares. I used Kona Snow.
- One 4" lavender or orchid square for the center of the nine patch.

Using the 2 at a time method* for making 1/2 square triangles make:

4 lavender + white half square triangles



4 print + white half square triangles

Square up all of your half square triangles to be 4" squares. Sew 9 patch together as shown in the diagram with your solid lavender square in the center.

You should end up with an 11" block.

*Two at a time method for half square triangles:


Place two squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on one square from corner to corner. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the line. Cut triangles apart on the line. Press seams open.
